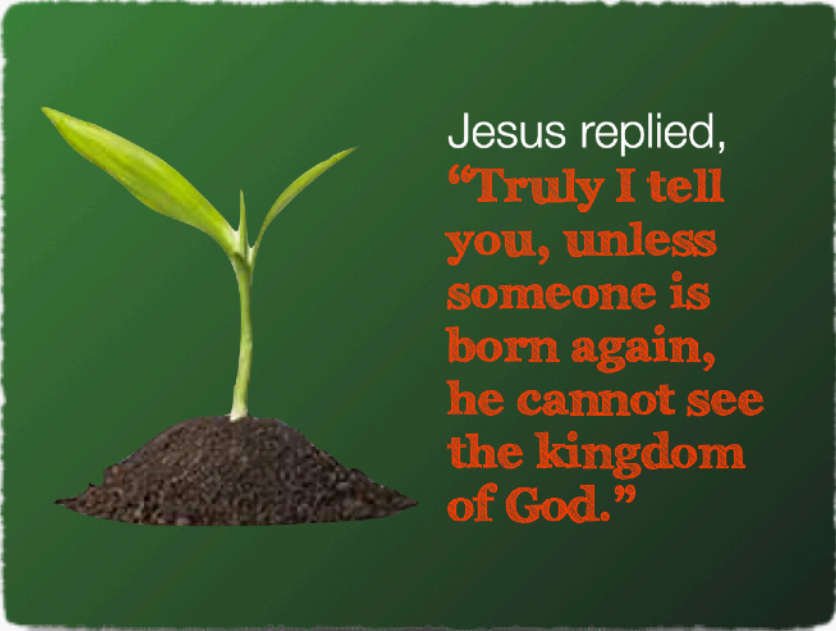
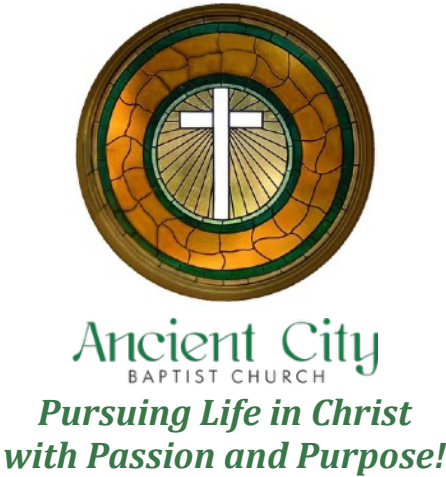

Bibles for Uganda: In the past couple of weeks, we have received almost \$700 toward the provision of additional Bibles for the pastors and members of some of the churches in Uganda that were part of the conferences our pastor helped lead during his trip there in January.
